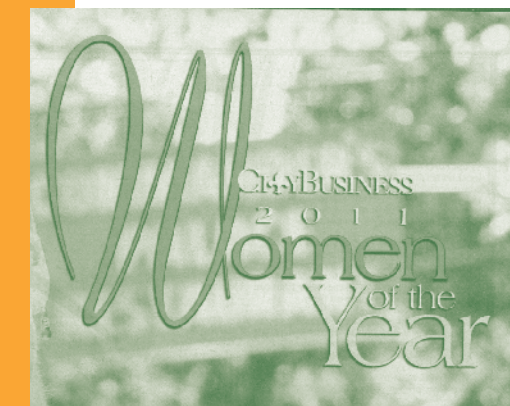
**BAKER DONELSON** – Tennessee-based Baker Donelson opened their doors in New Orleans in 2004 with 17 employees and a belief in a supportive family-oriented workplace. Shareholder Steve Griffith helped open the firm when he joined as an associate in 2004. He says the openness of the firm impressed him, adding that management let him know exactly where he stood and provided feedback, mentoring and training programs.

Griffith's role with the firm has grown into recruiting other attorneys. The firm looks for qualities beyond being well-rounded and high academics: the desire to perform community service and some type of pro-bono work. "The firm is very strong in pro-bono activity and encourages its lawyers to do the same," he said. "Lewis Donelson III taught me that being a lawyer isn't just about representation of existing clients that allow you to make money, but lawyers have higher duties to the community as a whole."

**KING, KREBS & JURGENS** – King, Krebs & Jurgens employees are impressed with the whole package right from the start. From baby showers to support in living healthier lives, the tone of the office promotes a sense of ownership for everyone.

Managing partner David Strauss said the goal is to keep things as relaxed and friendly as possible for everyone. "We invest in the people who work here at all levels," Strauss said. "I know there are firms who really only do that sort of thing with their associates, but the view here is that associates are only as good as the staff members who are supporting them." That investment includes up to \$1,800 a year in tuition assistance, a continuing education program and paying cell phone bills for their partners and providing associates with \$100 per month toward theirs. King, Krebs & Jurgens is also committed to community outreach, attorneys provide at least 50 hours of pro bono work per year, up from the previous 25.
