

TECHNOLOGY CENTER GRAND OPENING

On April 23, the GE Capital Technology Center, located on the 30th floor of Place St. Charles, held its official grand opening celebration. Governor Bobby Jindal and Mayor Mitch Landrieu joined approximately 80 GE Capital employees to celebrate the Center's success and, reiterate their support for GE's investment in New Orleans and commitment to jobs growth in Louisiana.

Brackett Denniston, GE Vice President and General Counsel and Martha Poulter, Vice President and GE Capital Chief Information Officer reaffirmed they had made the right decision to establish the Technology Center in a state committed to GE's growth and the growth of the technology industry as a whole.



Since moving to the city in 2012, GE Capital has created 100 IT professional jobs and will be bringing more dynamic IT talent to downtown New Orleans. The Center specializes in software engineering and information technologies implementing innovative solutions for GE Capital.
