Everything New Orleans-themed... from paintings and photographs to slates and hand towels, jewelry, clay and ceramic items, ornaments and more!

#### OUR FAVORITE LOCAL ARTISTS AND THEIR CRAFTS INCLUDE:

**SHAUN ALEMAN** The food, music, local festivals and catch phrases of South Louisiana are subject matter for native, Shaun Aleman. Full of New Orleans' unique heritage and culture, original paintings in watercolor and acrylic with handmade frames, are fashioned out of reclaimed wood from New Orleans houses. The collection also includes notecards and prints.

**ART WITH GRATITUDE** Creator Celeste McCann offers hand-painted whimsical images on rustic wood and slate. She signs each piece "with gratitude," a small personal prayer in thanks for her talent.

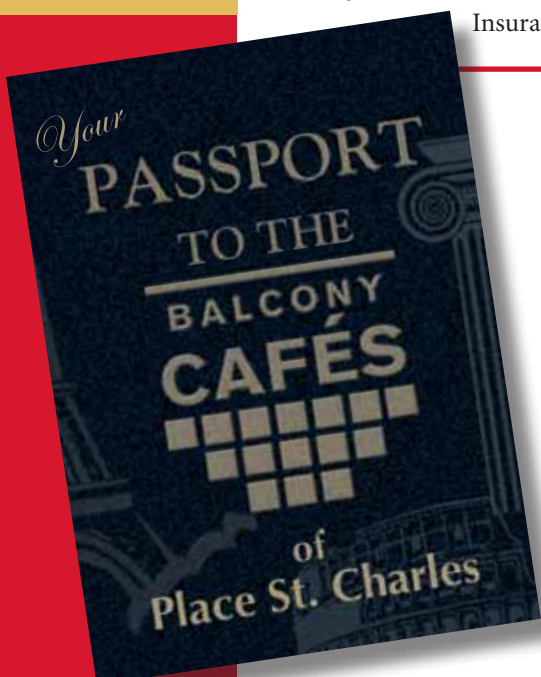
