The collection also includes notecards and prints.

ART WITH GRATITUDE Creator Celeste McCann offers handpainted whimsical images on rustic wood and slate. She signs each piece "with gratitude," a small personal prayer in thanks for her talent.

JOCELYN BURRELL Designer Jocelyn Burrell is famous for wonderfully handcrafted bronze and sterling hammered jewelry plus holiday ornaments that are haute couture for the Christmas tree!
