OUR FAVORITE LOCAL ARTISTS AND THEIR CRAFTS INCLUDE:

SHAUN ALEMAN The food, music, local festivals and catch phrases of South Louisiana are subject matter for native, Shaun Aleman. Full of New Orleans' unique heritage and culture, original paintings in watercolor and acrylic with handmade frames, are fashioned out of reclaimed wood from New Orleans houses. The collection also includes notecards and prints.

AMITA SAUNDARYA Bringing natural skincare into the realm of spirit, Amita Saundarya products are handmade with love and infused with Sanskrit mantras to energetically raise vibration. They are made with the highest quality plant-based ingredients and purest essential oils.
